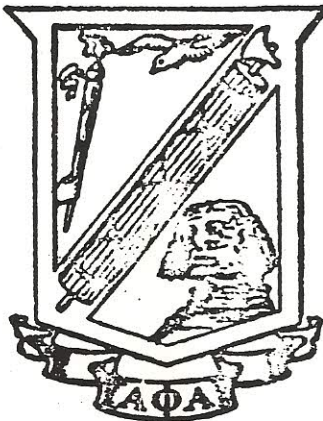

Know All Men By These Presents:

1. That the General Organization of the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity pursuant to and by virtue of its authority does hereby order, grant, ordain and establish a chapter of the said General Organization of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, said chapter to be known as

THETA IOTA LAMBDA

chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, and to be located at the seat of

in the city of SPRINGFIELD in the state of MASSACHUSETTS

2. That said chapter shall be subject to and bound by the Constitution, By-Laws, Ritual, Rules and Regulations of the General Organization of the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity.
 3. That said chapter shall be entitled to and shall enjoy all the rights and privileges, and only such rights and privileges as are granted to, delegated to and extended to it by the General Organization of the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity.
 4. That this charter shall be the expression of the authority and the legal existence of said chapter, and shall be held by said chapter except when by vote of the General Organization of the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, assembled in convention, it shall be withdrawn and the chapter declared non-existent.
